

MINUTES  
SPECIAL MEETING, SEPTEMBER 18, 1990

The special 9/18/90 meeting of the Collinsville City Council was convened at 7:06 p.m. by Mayor Quattlebaum. Present were Councilmen Enderby, Morgan, Schindler, and Davenport.

III. Tammy Court Ordinance # 270. The issue is for the Council to accept the street named Tammy Court, Denton Addition. Denton Brothers have put \$2,000.00 in escrow with the City to furnish materials for finishing the street. The street is curbed, guttered, and rocked; ready for the County to finish. The motion to accept the street was made by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

Goodjohn Street. The street at its present use is on railroad property in some places. The ordinance #269 waives the requirement for boundary line setback clearances on the house on lots 4 and 5, Block 3, Neathery Addition, owned by Charlece Roberts et. al. The motion to so waive was made by Mr. Davenport, seconded by Mr. Morgan, and carried.

Reserve Officer Ordinance. Revision of ordinance #101A to change the residence requirement of the reserve officers, and for reserve officers to be supervised by the Officer in Charge, the Mayor, and the Council. Added to the ordinance is a statement about discipline and discharge of an officer who may show behavior inconsistent with that required of an officer. The motion to approve Ordinance 101A as revised was made by Mr. Schindler, seconded by Mr. Davenport, and carried. A motion to include reserve officers on the workers compensation roll was made by Mr. Schindler, seconded by Mr. Morgan and carried.

II. Construction. There are about four (4) miles of road which are ready for oil. The schedule now is for 9/20/90. Ditches on the west side of town are cleared and also some in the northeast area of town.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Morgan, seconded by Mr. Enderby, and carried at 7:40 p.m.
