

Minutes

Regular Meeting, June 9, 1992

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session on June 9, 1992. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 P.M., by Mayor Quattlebaum. Present was Council Members Enderby, Meador, Perdue, Davenport and Anderson.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved with a motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Enderby and carried. Minutes of a special meeting held on May 16, 1992, was approved with a motion by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried. Financial report was approved by motion from Mr. Davenport, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

Old Business:

Construction

A. Motion to advertise for Audit Bids was made by Mr. Davenport, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

B. Mayor Quattlebaum spoke concerning re-occurring breaks in the water line located under South Main Street. Due to the age of the existing line and the cost of repeated repairs, it is believed the solution is to bore under the street and install a new line. A permit to bore under Main street, also known as Business 377, has been obtained from the Highway Dept. Motion to proceed with a new line was made by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

C. Broadway Property-Public hearing

Mr. Homer Caston, City Attorney, presented the Ordinance narrowing Broadway Street to 50 Ft. and the closing of Michigan, Dorchester, and Jones Streets. Property owners present from the area in question was Mr. and Mrs. A.J. Branch and Mr. Ed Anderson.

Following the reading of the Ordinance, a request for public comment was opened. Mrs. Branch asked if the city would retain Right-Of-Way on the abandoned property. Mayor Quattlebaum explained the necessity of the city retaining a utility easement. There were no objections presented concerning the proposal.

Motion to adopt Ordinance # 282 was made by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

Mr. Homer Caston reported of an agreement concerning the division of Dorchester and Michigan Streets. Mr. Caston stated Mr. & Mrs. Hernandez agreed to give their portion of Dorchester street to Mr. & Mrs. A.J. Branch. He also reported Mr. & Mrs. Peterman having made an agreement to give their portion of Michigan street to Mr. Ed Anderson. A waiver for the Hernandez and the Petermans is being prepared by Mr. Caston.

New business:

A. Street Work

The need to repair and /or re-surface several streets was presented by Mayor Quattlebaum. The council expressed their desire to upgrade as many streets as possible, as soon as weather permits. Motion to go forward with the work was made by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Anderson, and carried.

B. Radio Units

The council was informed of communication problems with the present units. Mayor Quattlebaum told of several occasions of poor or no communications between the city office and mobile units. A brochure and price list for two mobile units and a base unit was presented, the cost of said units will be approximately \$2312.00. A motion to purchase new equipment was made by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Anderson, and Carried.

C. Personnel

The applications recieved, for Water Maintance work, was reported by Mayor Quattlebaum. Mr. David Ratcliff met with the Mayor at an earlier date to express his interest in the position. Mr. Ratcliff is presently employed with the City Of Gainesville Water Dept. He holds a C License in Water and in Sewer. Mr. Bill Cox of Collinsville was present to speak to the council concerning his interest in the position. Mr. Cox presented a resume but stated he did not have a license in Water or Sewer at this time, but is willing to obtain the necessary license as soon as possible. Mr. Davenport stated his desire to speak with Mr. Ratcliff before making a decission. A motion to ask Mr. Ratcliff to meet with the council at 3:30 P.M. June 14, 1992, was made by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

Motion to adjourn by Mr. Perdue, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried at 8:50.
