

Regular Meeting, December 8, 1992

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session Dec. 8, 1992.

The meeting was convened at 7 P.M., by Mayor Quattlebaum.

Councilmembers present were Mr. Enderby, MEADOR, Anderson, and Davenport.

Minutes of the regular meeting, Nov. 10, 1992, were approved with motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

Motion to approve minutes of Special Meeting of Nov. 19, 1992 by Mr. Davenport, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

Motion to approve minutes of Special Meeting on Nov. 24, 1992, by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

Financial report for November was approved with motion by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

Old Business: Construction

Sewer Line - Summit Street

Sewer drainage problems are occurring repeatedly in the 400 block of north Summit Street. The Mayor suggested replacing the old lines as well as re-routing to eliminate the existing loop.

It is believed this would relieve the poor drainage as well as help with infiltration during the rainy season. Motion to replace appx. 2 blocks of existing line was made by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Anderson, and carried.

II.

Chamber Project;

Mr. Don Cox approached the council requesting consideration of a future Chamber project for safer parking on the West side of Main street between Hughes and the bank drive thru window.

. Cox will contact the State Hwy. Dept. for approval and report the State's decision to the council. Permission for Mr. Cox to proceed was given with motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried.

New Business; Retirement Program

A report on the estimated cost to the City to adopt a retirement program thru TMRS was given by the City Secretary. All full time employees will be given the opportunity to join, altho membership will not be mandatory. Contributions will be made by the employee and the City on a 1 for 1 ratio. Motion to adopt Plan I was made by Mr. Enderby, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried.

Repeal Ordinance # 210

Mayor Quattlebaum reported receiving several request from the State Hwy. Dept. and Union Pacific Railroad, for the removal of stop signs at R/R crossings on Elm and Hughes Street. Each crossing is now protected with Safety arm devices and the consensus being the signs are no longer needed. A motion to repeal a portion of Ordinance # 210 was made by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Davenport, and carried.

III.

4 Way Stop

A request for a 4 way stop at Pecan & Walnut was presented by the Mayor. Residence in the area believe this will slow the traffic on Pecan St., making it safer for the school children. Motion to make the Pecan st and Walnut intersection a 4 way stop was made by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Anderson, and carried.

Personnel

Mayor Quattlebaum ask the council to consider Mr. Todd Henry for full time employment. Mr. Henry holds a C license in water & is scheduled to take the exam to obtain a C license in Waste-Water. The Mayor stated Mr. Henry has agreed to take the position as Water Supervisor for the fee of 1900.00 per month, beginning on Jan. 2, 1993

In order to obtain permanent position Mr. Henry will be required to obtain his license in Waste Water.

Motion to hire Mr. Todd Henry was made by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Enderby, and carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8 P.M. with motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried.
