

Minutes, regular Meeting, March 9, 1994

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session Tuesday, March 9, 1994. The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Quattlebaum at 7 P.M..

Councilmembers present were Enderby, Perdue, Meador and Anderson. Minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved with motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Perdue, and carried. The financial report of the previous meeting was read and approved with motion by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried.

Old Bus: Construction

A Sewer and Water service For Walker and Wallis;

Eyvone Walker and Bob Wallis have requested water and sewer service in the North part of the city. Mr. Wallis will be building a new business on 377 North and Mrs. Walker is moving a trailer home on North Main street.

Water and sewer service for Mrs. Walker and Mr. Wallis will be connected to the lines on west side of the street on North Main.

An easement has been given to the city for purpose of installing water and sewer to all property adjacent to Hwy 377. Mrs. Walker and Mr. Wallis requested the city to install water and sewer lines to their property. Each party agreed to pay all expenses, which includes backhoe, man power, materials.

Motion to approve was made by Mr. Anderson, sec. by Mr. Perdue and carried.

B. Request For Sewer Jet;

An application for sewer jet service was read by the city secretary. Due to past disputes concerning the charges for this service, it will be necessary for an application to be signed by the tenant or property owner.

The current charge is \$ 30.00 for this service and must be paid within 10 days after service is rendered. If the charges has not been paid within 10 days, the signing of the APPLICATION GIVES THE CITY AUTHORIZATION TO ADD THE CHARGES TO THE WATER BILL, WITH disconnection of service if not paid.

C. Water Bill Extension;

Following a lengthy discussion of ways to stop the abuse of the current extension policy, a motion was made by Mr. Anderson, sec, by Mr. Perdue and Carried, to add 10% per day with a limit of 5 Days.

New Business;

A Audit Report-Jerry Seligman

Mr. Seligman presented the council with the audit report for fiscal year ending June 30, 1993. He reported all records in good condition with no suggestions for any changes in the present bookkeeping system.

B. Motion to call election;

Motion to call an election for the purpose of electing 3 Council members wa made by Mr. Meador, sec. By Mr. Anderson And carried. Election will be held on May 7, 1994.

No Parking Stewart and Graham Street:

A petition has been signed by residents of Stewart and Graham streets, asking the city to make the street no parking on either side at anytime.

The request was made due to the streets narrow width.

An Ordinance prohibiting parking on either side of Stewart or Graham Street has been prepared and was read by the secretary.

Motion to accept Ordinance # 301 was made by Mr. Meador, sec. by Mr. Anderson, and carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:08 p.m. with motion by Mr. Perdue, sec. by Mr. Meador, and carried.
