

## MINUTES

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session January 10, 1995. The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Mayor Quattlebaum. Present were Councilmembers Woolsey, Enderby and Perdue.

Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved with motion by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Perdue and carried.

The financial report for December was approved with motion by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Perdue and carried.

### Old Business:

Construction: Mayor Quattlebaum reported to the Council that Mr. John Grider asked that the City pay one-half (1/2) of the expense to have a tree removed in the alley behind his residence at 509 Stone Street. The total cost will be \$700.00, with the City paying \$350.00. Motion was made for the City to pay one-half [1/2] of the expense to remove the tree, by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Perdue and carried.

### New Business:

A. Fire Department Emergency Response: Chief Damon Stewart addressed the Council concerning E.M.S. for this area. The ambulance service in Whitesboro has requested the assistance of the Collinsville Volunteer Fire Department to help with the location in this area. CVFD Unit 71 will be the only unit to respond. Personal vehicle's will not respond. Unit 71 will run with at least two [2] Volunteer Firemen. CVFD will only respond to assist the Ambulance Medical Team. Council passed Resolution to allow CVFD to become First Response members to assist in emergency cases. Motion was made by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Woolsey and carried.

B. Personnel: Motion to remove trial period for Richard Skipworth, with a salary increase of \$100.00 per month, and remove trial period for Nancy Davidson, with a salary increase of \$50.00 per month. Motion made by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Perdue and carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Perdue, seconded by Mr. Enderby and carried at 8:00 p.m.
