

MINUTES

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session May 9, 1995. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mayor D.M. Quattlebaum. Present were Council members Anderson, Enderby, McCorkle, Perdue, Woolsey and Council elect Wesley Overstreet, and Jo Walkup.

Minutes of the April regular meeting were read and approved with motion by Mr. McCorkle, seconded by Mr. Enderby and carried.

The financial report for April was approved with motion by Mr. Anderson, seconded by Mr. McCorkle and carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

CONSTRUCTION:

- (a) Mayor Quattlebaum discussed the replacement of the sewer lines, along with the possibilities of re-routing some of the lines. A map was provided to Council members for review of the North part of the town on the sewer lines that have been replaced with PVC. Mayor Quattlebaum also discussed the possibility of increase in the town size and how to accommodate this increase.

- (b) Councilmember Wayne McCorkle submitted his resignation as Councilmember. Motion to accept was made by Mr. Enderby, seconded by Mr. Anderson and carried.

Canvass Votes:

- (c) Mayor Quattlebaum and Councilmembers Anderson and Enderby retired to canvass the votes of the May 6, 1995 election. Votes were accepted as reported.

Oath of Office:

- (d) Mayor Quattlebaum swore in Wesley Overstreet and Jo Walkup as Councilmembers and Wayne McCorkle as Mayor.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Anderson, seconded by Mr. Perdue and carried at 8:45 p.m.
