

Minutes

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session Oct.10,1995. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mayor McCorkle. Present were Councilmembers Wesley Overstreet, Damon Woolsey and Jo Walkup. Also present were Mr. And Mrs. John Beall and Ms. York.

Old Business:

A. Construction- Mayor McCorkle updated the council of sewer line replacements which include Hwy 377 between Ford Street and Mr Culpepper's property, as well as Stone street from DeWitt to Main. Construction will continue as long as weather permits.

B. Zoning and Building Ordinance:

Mr. Woolsey is gathering information for possible ordinance structure which will be presented at the Nov. meeting.

New Business:

A. Passage Of Ordinance # 309

Ordinance # 309 designating a 4-way stop at Hughes and Walnut was passed with motion by Mr. Overstreet sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.

B. Passage Of Ordinance # 310

Ordinance # 310 for the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Pearce and Elm was passed with motion by Ms. Walkup sec. by Mr. Overstreet and carried.

C. Maintenance at East Park- John Beall

Mr. Beall approached the council concerning the maintenance for the section used by Mrs. Beall for soccer practice. He stated he had been keeping this mowed and would continue if the City did not object. Mayor McCorkle thanked Mr. Beall for his interest and work and promised more help from city workers as soon as possible.

F. Officer In Charge - Police Dept.

The council was informed of the difficulty of reaching Officer In Charge Eric Stout to sign papers and/or answer questions. Motion was made by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Overstreet and carried to give the Mayor the authority to meet with the officers and make changes if necessary.

G. Diesel Pump at City Barn

Mayor McCorkle expressed his desire to postpone action concerning a diesel pump until all councilmembers were present. Motion to table was made by Mr. Woolsey, sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.

H. Motion was made by Mr. Woolsey, sec. by Mr. Overstreet and carried to accept the County Fire Contract.
