

## Minutes

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session February 10, 1997.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Mayor McCorkle.

Present were Councilmembers Thomas Byrom, Wesley Overstreet, Randy Woody and Jo Walkup.

Minutes of the January meeting was approved with motion by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried.

Minutes of a Special meeting January 20, 1997 was read and approved with motion by Mr. Overstreet sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried.

Minutes of a Special meeting January 27, 1997 was read and approved with motion by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.

The January financial report was accepted with motion by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried.

### Old Business:

#### A. & C. -- Construction & Street work

County workers are currently preparing Stone, Locust, Pecan & Hughes for re-surfacing. A motion was made by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried, to submit an Interlocal Agreement request for topping of the following streets: Stone, Locust, Pecan, Hughes, DeWitt, Denton Ct, Tammy Ct and South Neathery.

Councilmembers discussed the possibility of placing speed bumps on Broadway Extension in an effort to slow traffic in the school zone. Concern for the safety of the children walking to and from school on Woodland street was also discussed. The installation of a sidewalk from the school entrance to the football field is under consideration.

#### B. Water Service 377 South--Jerry Weaver

Mr. Weaver approached the council asking for water service at his residence on the west side of Hwy. 377 south. Mr. Weaver also stated that Larry Crow has indicated his desire for two meters on the west side of the highway. Motion was made by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Mr. Woody and carried with 1 opposing vote by Ms. Walkup, to grant Mr. Weaver water service. Others wishing to receive service will need to meet with council for approval

#### D. Shed For Fire Dept.

### New Business:

#### A. Carport----Larry Millson

Mr. Millson was not present.

#### B. Sewer & Water Drainage Problems ---Bob Rowe

Mr. Rowe was present to speak on behalf of his mother-in-law, Letha Clements, concerning water drainage problems at her residence on Summitt street. He asked if the ditches could be cleaned out on Collinsville street to relieve the backup on personal property. Motion was made by Mr. Byrom sec. by Mr. Overstreet and carried to have County official Frank Weir check the location and do what he feels will correct the situation. Mr. Rowe asked if the City intended to do cleanup work in front of Mrs. Clements house where the ditches have been cleaned out. Mayor Mc Corkle assured him that work would resume as soon as weather permits.

The sewer problems in that area will be determined when the lines are TV'd within the next few weeks.

C. Tower Maintenance Well # 2  
Tabled until a later date.

D. Call For Election

Motion was made by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried to call an election May 3, 1997 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and 2 Councilmembers.

A maintenance agreement between the City and Texas Dept. of Transportation was approved with motion by Mr. Overstreet, sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.
