

Minutes

The Regular Meeting of the Collinsville City Council was convened at 7:03 p.m., May 13, 1997, by Mayor McCorkle. Present were Councilmembers Thomas Byrom, Jim Perdue, Randy Woody, Jo Walkup & Councilman Elect Ronald Vannoy.

Minutes of the Emergency Meeting held April 7th was approved with motion by Ms. Walkup, sec. by Mr. Woody and carried.

Minutes of a Special Meeting held April 9th was approved with motion by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.

Minutes of the Regular April Meeting was approved with motion by Mr. Woody, sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried.

The April financial report was accepted with motion by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Ms. Walkup and carried.

Old Business:

Construction:

Mayor McCorkle reported on the following items:

- A. Water and Sewer service to Denton Addition on N. Broadway is completed.
- B. Installation of two fire hydrants---1 on the ^{South} ~~north~~ side of the High-School ----1 at Denton Addition.
- C. Water service on N. Broadway and Old Collinsville/Whitesboro Road, will be converted from the existing 2" line to the 6" line following the results of the water samples taken from the new line.
- D. Billy Lemmons is to move the Slack house the week of the 19th.

New Business:

A. Oath of Office --- Mayor

The City Secretary administered the Oath of Office to Mayor-Elect Wayne McCorkle.

- B. Oath of Office was administered, by the city Secretary, to Councilmember -elect Ronald Vannoy. Motion was made by Randy Woody sec. by Ronnie Vannoy and carried, to appoint Thomas Byrom as Mayor Pro-Tem.

C. Petition to annex into City Limits--Bill Schindler

Mr. Schindler was present representing 5 homeowners on 902 East that are requesting annexation of their property into the city limits in order to obtain sewer service to their residence.

An annexation covenant between the City of Collinsville and property owners was presented to Mr. Schindler.

He was assured that sewer service would be made available if all property owners involved agreed to the provisions listed in the annexation.

Mr. Schindler will meet with the owners and notify city officials of his findings.

D. Resolution ---Disposal Site

A Resolution supporting the efforts of Cooke & Grayson Counties to develop a disposal site was approved with motion by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Mr. Woody and carried.

E. Salary --- Jeff Williams

Officer Williams asked the council to consider an increase in his monthly salary. Officer Williams was assured his request would be discussed in the Executive Session.


F. Review of Police Officer Applications -- Executive Session
