

Minutes

A Special Meeting of the Collinsville City Council was called to order at 6:02 p.m., March 23, 1998, by Mayor McCorkle.

Present were Councilmembers Thomas Byrom, Ronnie Vannoy, Randy Woody and John Lahr.

Business:

A. Consideration & Action of purchase of property at 103 N. Main: Real Estate Agent Mr. Larry Millson was present representing Jerry & Barbara Henery, owners of property at 103 N. Main.

Mr. Millson reported that his client has agreed to sell the property adjacent to the City Hall, to the city for \$33,000.00 as opposed to the listed price of \$35,000.00. Council discussed the need for future expansion and the desire to keep the City Hall downtown for customer convenience, prompted the council decision to purchase the property at 103 N. Main at a cost of \$33,000.00.

Motion to purchase was made by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Mr. Lahr and Carried.

B. Sub-Division - S. Broadway--Sam Davis

Mr. Davis was present to address the council concerning 11 lots on S. Broadway that he has listed for sale. Mr. Davis is requesting the property be annexed into the city limits and sewer service extended to this area. The cost to extend the service will be appx. \$7000.00 for pipe and a lift station that must be installed, due to the elevation of the property. The lift station and pipe installation will be done by the city with Mr. Davis agreeing to reimburse all expenses for extension within 2 years.

Motion was made by Mr. Byrom sec. by Mr. Vannoy and carried, to accept the annexation and extend the sewer service when all the proper papers have been completed by Mr. Davis' attorney.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:42 with motion by Mr. Byrom, sec. by Mr. Lahr and carried.
