B. Truck Damage--Andy Hargis

Council reviewed 4 bids to repair damage to Mr. Hargis' truck by city vehicle.

Mr. Hargis stated he preferred to use Rasure Paint & Body Shop of Gainesville. Motion was made by Troy Vannoy sec. by Johnny Godsey and carried to allow Mr. Hargis to use Rasure and the city pay \$813.48 for the repairs.

C. Discuss Zoning Ordinance:

Continual growth in this area, prompted the council to consider zoning of the city. Mayor McCorkle is to speak with the attorney to determine what would be suitable for the city.

D. Ammonia Nitrate: Mark Patterson

Mr. Patterson spoke concerning high levels of Ammonia Nitrate at the sewer plant. In effort to reduce the level, sand has been removed from the plant and sludge cleaned from other areas. Every effort is being done to correct the problem.
