

MINUTES

The Collinsville City Council met in regular session January 14, 2002 at 7 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mc Corkle.

Present were council members Thomas Byrom, Dare Nolen, Troy Vannoy, Johnny Godsey & John Lahr.

Old Business:

a. Planning & Zoning ---Bobbie Vannoy

Ms. Vannoy presented the council with the P. & Z. committee recommendations for city zoning. The recommendations were approved and Ordinance # 371, regulating the location of manufactured homes, was adopted by motion of Mr. Byrom sec. by Mr. Nolen and carried. Ordinance # 372 setting the fee for a zone change request or specific use permit was adopted by motion of Mr. Godsey, sec. by Mr. Lahr and carried.

b. Construction:

Mark reported the installation of water service at the new school is completed and plans for the sewer service are currently being discussed.

New Business:

a. Park Board --Melanie Graves

Ms. Graves spoke to the council concerning clean up at the city park. She stated the park board will do the work if the city will allow them the use of city equipment such as weed eater, mower, etc. Permission was granted and a copy of Ms. Graves request is attached.

b. Resolution For Law Enforcement Grant:

Officer Brad Stone presented the council with a Resolution allowing the police department to submit a grant application for funds to be used for police equipment. Motion to approve Resolution was made by Mr. Byrom sec. by Mr. Vannoy and carried.

c. Officer Stone also submitted a Resolution prohibiting Racial Profiling for council approval. The Resolution was approved with motion by Mr. Godsey sec. by Mr. Vannoy and carried.

d. Extra Hours for Brad Stone:

Officer Stone ask for an additional 5 to 8 hours per week for computer work and state reporting requirements. Motion to allow no more than 8 hours per week on a four months trial basis was made by Mr. Vannoy sec. by Mr. Byrom and carried.

e. Approve Sales Tax Board Members:

Motion was made by Mr. Godsey sec. by Mr. Nolen and carried to approve the appointment of Wayne Mohundro to serve the unexpired term of Don Cox on sales tax section 4 A.
