

MINUTES

SPECIAL MEETING

A Special Meeting of the Collinsville City Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m., April 24, 2002 by Mayor McCorkle.

Present were council members Dare Nolen, Troy Vannoy Johnny Godsey and John Lahr.

Business:

A. County Attorney Joseph Brown met with the council seeking authorization of a Resolution to include the city in a lawsuit against Life Tech EMS, Inc. for Breach of Contract. Mr. Brown stated the assets of Life Tech have been frozen by court order. The county has filed a lien up to \$200,000.00 against money owed to Life Tech by Medicare and other Insurance agencies. Mr. Brown states that at this time Life Tech has not filed for bankruptcy but he believes they will. The lawsuit will be handled by the county attorney's office at no cost to the city. The county will pay for any outside lawyer fees if necessary to handle bankruptcy issues.

Motion was made by Mr. Godsey, sec by Mr. Nolen and carried unanimously to pass the Resolution authorizing Joseph Brown to file suit against Life Tech for Breach of Contract on behalf of the City of Collinsville.

B. Agreement Contract to purchase Skidmore property was not received therefore no council action was taken.

The meeting adjourned at 7:27 p.m. by motion by Mr. Godsey, sec. by Mr. Nolen and carried.
