

## SPECIAL MEETING

The Collinsville City Council met in a Special Session, September 30, 2005.  
The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Mayor Kerr.  
Present were council members Brandon White, Grady Carney, Troy Vannoy and James Fritts.

### New Business :

#### a. Discuss & Act on approval of new construction on 902 West :

Council reviewed the plans for a new house on 902 west. The plans have passed through the P. & Z. Committee and a motion to accept the plans was made by Mr. Fritts second by Mr. White and carried.

#### b. Discuss & Act on repair of backhoe:

Council discussed several options regarding the problems with the backhoe. The options were replace the engine, check on cost of lease to own or purchase through bank loan. Motion to table until more information can be obtained was made by Mr. Fritts second by Mr. Vannoy and carried.

#### c. Discuss & Act on Ordinance changing date & time of council meetings:

A Resolution changing the time & date of the monthly council meetings from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday at 7 p.m. to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday at 6 p.m. was passed and approved with motion by Mr. Carney second by Mr. White and carried.

#### d. Discuss & Act on Bureau Vertias inspections:

New state requirements for building inspections and to assure the inspectors are certified by the state prompted the city council to consider contracting with Bureau Vertias to inspect all new and remodeling construction. All inspectors of the company are certified by the state to inspect electrical, plumbing, structure, etc. Motion was made by Mr. Fritts sec. by Mr. Carney and carried to contract with Bureau Vertias to handle all of the city inspections. The fee for inspection will depend on the cost of the construction plus a \$ 50.00 fee for city record keeping.

#### e. Discuss & Act on carport on Elder Street:

Mr. Voyles has requested a set back variance for a carport on his property located at 604 Elder Street. The P. & Z. Committee has researched the request and found no problems with the variance. Motion to grant the variance was made by Mr. Fritts Second by Mr. White and carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:03 p.m. with motion by Mr. Fritts second by Mr. Vannoy and carried.
